Methodology

This survey was conducted from April 25-26, 2025 among a sample of 1320 voters in Saskatoon. The survey was conducted using IVR (Interactive Voice Response) to landlines and cell phones which could be verified with a postal code in Saskatoon.

The data in this report have been weighted to be representative of gender and age according to statistics from StatsCan.

The margin of error for a poll of this size is +/- 2.69% at the 95% confidence level.

Margins of error at the 95% confidence level for the riding break outs:


Saskatoon-University: 4.50%






